



INFORMATION FOR POST EXAMS

NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS

- GCSE results will be available for collection on Thursday 21st August 2025.
- Students are invited to collect their results between 10.30 am and 12.30 pm from Hurn Bridge Sports Club, Avon Causeway, Hurn, Parley BH23 6DY.



- If you wish any other person (including family members) to collect your results on your behalf, you must give your written authorisation to school. The person collecting must bring photographic ID.
- Results not collected on Thursday 21st August 2025 will be posted first class to the students' home address. If you are not planning to collect your results on 21st August, please ensure that we have your current address on your Arbor record.

Please Note: No results will be given out by telephone under any circumstances.

POST RESULTS

- A list of post-results services will be included in the envelope with your results. If you need post-results advice, the Exams Officer, Senior Leaders and some teaching staff will be available on Results Day.
- If you feel that marks are not accurate and wish to request a Review of Results (RoR) and/or an Access to Scripts (ATS) service you will need to complete the form included with your results and return this to info@reachsouth.org by 23/09/2025.
- If a Review of Results is recommended by the Parkfield Senior Leadership Team, Reach South Trust will cover the cost. If a Review of Results is at your request, payment should be made to Reach South Academy Trust, 30-64-18, 68799868, with "PKF" and student name as the reference.
- Costs vary depending on the Exam Board and which service is requested. This is typically between £40 and £65. Costs for art moderation are substantially higher (typically £260). Admin fees may also be added. Please send any cost enquiries to info@reachsouth.org
- If you wish to make a request after results day, please contact info@reachsouth.org
- **Please note: A parent/guardian/third party cannot give consent or request this service on behalf of the candidate, nor are they permitted to request details regarding the candidate's results.**
- NO REQUESTS WILL BE PROCESSED WITHOUT A COMPLETED CONSENT FORM. All outcomes will be relayed to the candidate once received from the examination boards.
- The deadline for return of these forms to info@reachsouth.org and payment is **23/09/2025**.

COLLECTION OF CERTIFICATES

- Certificates will be posted out from Millbay Academy, Plymouth, in November.
- If your address or contact details change, you should email exams@millbayacademy.org as soon as possible and, at the latest, by Friday 24th October 2025.
- If candidates lose their certificates, they can only be replaced by direct application to the appropriate examination boards. This will require proof of identity (such as a birth certificate) and a substantial fee per examination board. You are therefore urged to ensure your contact details are up-to-date and any changes are notified.
